







About HSUHK

The Hang Seng University of Hong Kong (HSUHK) is a non-profit private liberal-arts-oriented university in Hong Kong. Adopting the "Liberal + Professional" education model, HSUHK is a residential institution which puts quality teaching and students' all-round development as its highest priorities. All undergraduate and postgraduate programmes offered by HSUHK were accredited by The Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ).

Support to International Students*

All-round support will be provided to international students once they are admitted to HSUHK, e.g. assisting them in applying for HKSAR student visas. Students and their parents will be invited to join various orientation activities as well as the "President's Reception for Parents, Teachers and Students" which will be held in October each year to enhance their understanding of HSUHK and Hong Kong. In addition, the Student Affairs Office will support the accommodation arrangement, student guidance service, career counselling and exchange programmes, etc. to help students engaging with the university life.

- According to the Education Bureau (EDB), international students who hold the following visa / permit issued by the Immigration Department of the HKSAR are defined as non-local students.
 - · student visa / entry permit; or

 - visa under the Immigration Arrangements for Non-local Graduates; or
 dependent visa (students who were aged 18 years old or above when they were issued with such visa / entry permit by the Immigration Department of the HKSAR)

The "non-local" status of students, once determined at the point of admission, should not be changed due to the change of age during the study period.





Intercultural Experience: International Exchange Programmes

HSUHK offers international exchange opportunities to students with over 70 overseas institutions in 23 regions, including the Mainland, the UK, Finland, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland, Austria, Belgium, Romania, Latvia, Lithuania, France, Germany, the Netherlands, Israel, Canada, the US, Australia, Malaysia, Thailand, Korea and Japan, etc.

Strong Links with Industry: Extensive Internship Opportunities

More than 1,250 internship opportunities will be offered each year in the Mainland, Hong Kong, the UK, the US, Australia, Germany, Spain, Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, Korea and Japan, etc. to enhance students' employability after graduation.
